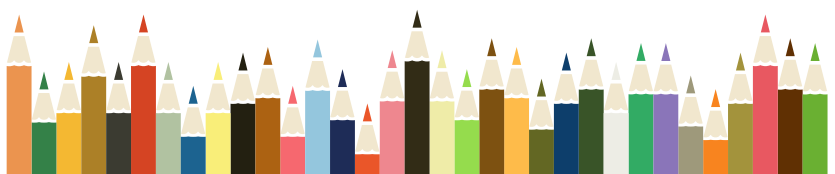

2. Visit osstf.on.ca and click on the ARM icon at the bottom of the webpage to access the ARM application form.

The annual membership fee of \$50, due 1 January each year, is waived until the January following your enrolment. If you join the ARM Health Plan your membership fee is collected with the January benefit premium. Half of your cost is rebated to our chapter to support our budgeted items.
